

## Ahh-Some Hot Tub & Jetted Bath Bio & Gunk Cleaner

### Jetted Tubs or Whirlpool Baths

**Fill the Jetted Tub or Whirlpool Bath over the top jets. You can use hot or cold water. It really doesn't matter.**

Add one (1) level teaspoon of our gel to the water. Swirl it around with your hand and start the motor so water comes out the jets. If you have an air intake nozzle (usually on top by the controls), open it to get ambient air to circulate into the tub and out the jets. **This will cause an almost instant foaming to occur. This is NORMAL. However, if your tub is overflowing with foam, you probably used too much.** If this should happen, Shut off the motor and drain the water down the tub drain. Add new water and decrease the amount of the gel by half. Run the jets 5 or ten minutes with the air intake valve (discussed previously), open. Run the jets 5 minutes or so. You should see brown specks and other dark colored particulates floating on the foam and clinging to the acrylic or porcelain tub. Drain the tub again and add about half the water you normally would to take a bath. Run the jets for a minute or so to get any clinging gunk from the jets that didn't come out previously. Rinse the tub with fresh water and wipe out the gunk that will be sticking to the inside of the tub. You may use regular bathroom cleaner to do this. **Always use any bathroom cleaner and our gel in a well ventilated room.** You may wish to open the bathroom door and/or open a window while cleaning the tub with our product. Our product is a non-toxic chemical friendly formula that lifts bio detritus from your internal plumbing system. If your tub is older and has not been properly cleaned in the past, it may be necessary to do this entire clean-out procedure numerous times. Each time you will see remnants of the bio and gunk that is inside your system. Layer by layer we will work off the plaque-like gunk that is spewing into your tub as brown or black flecks. You should use our product by itself with no other chemicals while the tub is in clean mode. Be assured that all the bacteria and nasty sounding and smelling particulates will be washed and rinsed down the drain after using our Ahh-Some gel. **If your tub looks real nasty after using our cleaner, this is normal. This means the stuff is working.** Rinse the tub and clean up entire bathtub area. You are now ready to take a bath in the cleanest jetted or whirlpool tub ever.

### Cleaning Hot Tubs or Spas

Every 90 days or so you should purge your hot tub of dead skin, harmful bacteria and other gunk that is clinging inside the plumbing infrastructure. This is a simple process. Add about 1 tablespoon of our gel to a 500 gallon hot tub just prior to your maintenance purge. Use less according to your hot tubs water capacity. Run the pump(s) and Blower to attain maximum circulation. Be sure to open the air intake valve at this time. Foaming will appear quickly inside the vessel. This is NORMAL. Run the jets and blower (if equipped), for 5-10 minutes or so. Now, turn off the pump and motors in the hot tub. Drain and rinse the tub with fresh water. Wipe it clean

as possible, getting the sticky gunk like stuff off the interior plastic acrylic sheet. Be sure to dump as much of the dirty water as possible after doing this cleaning purge. Ideally, you get all the water out of the tub after this cleaning. If your spa has an air channel (holes in the bottom), this will be very difficult unless you can literally lift the spa so that the water in the channel flow to one area that you can scoop out. That's it! Fill the Hot Tub with water to proper level. Add balancing chemicals and a sanitizer as usual. Remember to do this clean-out purge every 60-90 days so your water stays the freshest possible and maintains a clear and fresh look.

*Note: You may wish to add ½ teaspoon of our Hot Tub Bio-Cleaner weekly as a clarifier. This will not only enhance the look and feel of the water, but will actually lower the amount of sanitizer and other chemicals you presently use. Be sure to add the right amount. Too much will foam, too little will not be as effective. Play around with the dose needed to maintain your spa. When you see the difference in water clarity and feel, you too will agree. Ahh-Some is Awesome!*
